GOD WANTS TO HEAL YOU TODAY

When we cry out to God for mercy. He provides for our needs. Mercy provides forgiveness and also healing.

Mark 1:40-42 (NKJ)

40 Now a leper came to Him, imploring Him, kneeling down to Him and saying to Him, "If You are willing, you can make me clean."

41 Then Jesus, moved with compassion, stretched out His hand and touched him, and said to him, "I am willing; be cleansed." **42** As soon as He had spoken, immediately the leprosy left him, and he was cleansed

God is willing and able to heal us.

GOD STILL HEALS TODAY

Jesus Christ – who healed the lame, blind, deaf, and diseased – is the same healing God today.

Hebrews 13:8 (NKJ)

8 Jesus Christ is the same yesterday, today, and forever. God wants to heal every aspect of our being—heart, soul, body, mind, and spirit. And He wants the redeemed to pray for their healing as an act of trust and dependence on Him and to know where our ultimate source of healing comes from. While some aspects of our being are healed immediately, others He heals over time as a way of transforming us into Christ's likeness.

Our God is Jehovah Rapha (our Lord who heals)

Exodus 15:26

26 and said, "If you diligently heed the voice of the LORD your God and do what is right in His sight, give ear to His commandments and keep all His statutes, I will put none of the diseases on you which I have brought on the Egyptians. For I am the LORD who heals you."

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HERE ARE SEVEN WAYS GOD IS OUR HEALER, EVEN TODAY:

1. God heals physically

God work through a combination of medical treatment, natural remedies, and the prayers of His people. Jesus once told a woman who risked everything to touch Him, "your faith has made you well"

Matthew 9:22 (NKJ)

22 But Jesus turned around, and when He saw her He said, "Be of good cheer, daughter; your faith has made you well." And the woman was made well from that hour.

As we exercise wisdom and diligence to do what we can to be healthy, do you have faith that He can heal your physical infirmities today?

2. God heals the disease of sin

Jesus endured in His own body on the cross to heal our sin nature and free us of the ravages of sin.

Isaiah 53:5 (NKJ)

5 But He was wounded for our transgressions, He was bruised for our iniquities; The chastisement for our peace was upon Him, And by His stripes we are healed.

3. God heals the disease of self

We can invite Jesus into our lives and claim the gift of eternal life and call ourselves His children, but there is still the disease of self to be healed, even after the disease of sin has been atoned for. Thanks be to God; Jesus is the Only One who can cure us of the disease of self when we "die to self" and live unto Him.

Galatians 2:20 (NKJ)

20 I have been crucified with Christ; it is no longer I who live, but Christ lives in me; and the life which I now live in the flesh I live by faith in the Son of God, who loved me and gave Himself for me.

4. God heals emotionally

Sometimes emotional wounds can be deeper and more painful than physical injuries or illnesses. The absence of parental love, the pain of rejection or betrayal, the emotional horror of rape and abuse, or the unexplainable sorrow of losing a child, spouse, or anyone you deeply loved, can all seem incurable. God never designed us to experience that kind of grief, pain and sorrow.

Jesus heals those kinds of wounds that can't be cured through surgery, medication, or a positive attitude.

Psalms 147:3

3 He heals the broken-hearted And binds up their wounds

5. God heals spiritually

Many were raised in cults, or in Christian homes full of legalism, hypocrisy, judgment, and fleshly addictions. Yet, our view of Christ cannot be tainted by improper representations of Him by those who never knew Him or were poor imitations of Him. We must look at the person of Jesus and the description of God in Scripture to know His true character, or we can remain spiritually ill.

Psalms 139:23-24 (NKJ)

Search me, O God, and know my heart; Try me, and know my anxieties; **24** And see if there is any wicked way in me, and lead me in the way everlasting.

6. God heals past wounds

It's been said "time heals all wounds." I believe that happens when we give our wounds to God and trust that He can heal them, in His timing. Raw open wounds don't heal overnight. But, as we cultivate a lifestyle of trusting God, forgiving others, walking in His light, and clinging to His Word, He heals us of those past wounds we can't seem to overcome on our own.

2 Corinthians 5:17

Therefore, if anyone is in Christ, he is a new creation; old things have passed away; behold, all things have become new.

7. God heals mind and heart

Do you have a problem loving someone? Forgiving someone? Moving on past a certain hurt because your mind keeps replaying it? God is the Only One who can take care of that completely. Allow God to renew your mind—and heal it—through the constant reading and study of Scripture, through the company of others who obey His Word, and through a continual yielding to the direction and conviction of the Holy Spirit.

Romans 12:2 (NKJ)

2 And do not be conformed to this world, but be transformed by the renewing of your mind, that you may prove what is that good and acceptable and perfect will of God.

NB: Faith in God can heal any sickness, any affliction, any deformity. Faith in God will do it for you.
